BY-LAW NO. 80-89

BEING A BY-LAW OF THE MUNICIPAL DISTRICT OF BRAZEAU NO. 77, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, TO PROVIDE FOR THE ADOPTION OF A MODIFIED VOTING PROCEDURE

WHEREAS, the Council of the Municipal District of Brazeau No. 77 wishes to pass a By-Law authorizing the designation of more than one voting station per subdivision within the Municipality; and

NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to the Provisions of the Local Authorities Election Act, Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1980, and amendments thereto, and under the authority of Ministerial Order number 577/89 the Council of Municipal District of Brazeau No. 77, in the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:


1. THE Municipal District of Brazeau No. 77 hereby adopts the modified system of conducting an election as prescribed by Alberta Regulation No. 123/87.
2. THE modified voting procedure shall be used for the purpose of conducting elections pursuant to the provisions of the Local Authorities Election Act.
3. THIS by-law shall come into force and effect upon the date of the passing of the third and final reading.

READ a second time this 27th day of September, A.D., 1989.

READ a third time by unanimous consent of the Councillors present and finally passed this 27th day of September, A.D., 1989.
