

MUNICIPAL DISTRICT OF BRAZEAU NO. 77

BY-LAW NO. 136-91

BEING A BY-LAW OF THE MUNICIPAL DISTRICT OF BRAZEAU NO. 77, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH HER MAJESTY THE QUEEN, IN RIGHT OF THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, HEREIN REPRESENTED BY THE MINISTER OF TRANSPORTATION AND UTILITIES FOR THE PROVISION OF FUNDING FOR THE HAMLETS OF ROCKY RAPIDS AND CYNTHIA WATER SYSTEMS.

WHEREAS, under the provisions of Section 116 of the Municipal Government Act, being Chapter M-26 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1980, (as amended), the Council for the Municipal District of Brazeau No. 77, in the Province of Alberta, may pass a By-Law authorizing the making of an agreement with Her Majesty the Queen, in right of the Province of Alberta, hereinafter represented by the Minister of Transportation and Utilities, for the provision of funding for the Hamlets of Rocky Rapids and Cynthia Water Systems.

NOW THEREFORE, the Municipal Council for the Municipal District of Brazeau No. 77 in Council assembled enacts as follows:

THAT, the Reeve and Municipal Manager of the Municipal District of Brazeau No. 77 be and are hereby empowered to execute agreements as attached between the said Municipality and Her Majesty the Queen, in right of the Province of Alberta, hereinafter represented by the Minister of Transportation and Utilities, for the provision of funding for the Hamlets of Rocky Rapids and Cynthia Water Systems.

READ a first time this 26th day of June, A.D., 1991.

READ a second time this 26th day of June, A.D., 1991.

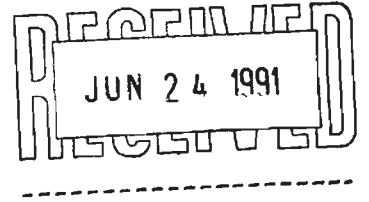
READ a third time with the unanimous consent of the Councillors present and finally passed this 26th day of June, A.D., 1991.

Re: Hamlet of Cynthia and Hamlet of Rocky Rapids

I am writing further to the Honourable Ken Kowalski's letter of May 14, 1991 regarding the approval for the above hamlets. Enclosed are two agreements for each hamlet for their respective water projects. Please have the agreements signed by the reeve and yourself and witnessed. The documents will be dated upon return to the department.

If these projects are to be tendered, please note that Alberta Transportation and Utilities adheres to the principle of awarding work to the lowest bidder. Municipalities must apply this principle when tendering projects funded by the department. If there are exceptional circumstances where the low bid on a public or invitational tender is considered unacceptable by the municipality, the municipality shall submit a written report requesting approval of an award to other than the low bidder. The report must clearly substantiate the reasons for the recommendation and provide details of all tenders received.

If you have the following information ready at this time, please include it along with the agreements for each project:

- 1) A copy of your summary of tenders,
- 2) A price schedule of the selected tender, and
- 3) The estimated date of construction start and/or information on what costs have been incurred to date.

Also enclosed is information relating to the posting of an information sign. It would be appreciated if you would erect the sign as requested in the sign specifications.


