

MUNICIPAL DISTRICT OF BRAZEAU NO. 77

BY-LAW NO. 130-91

BEING A BY-LAW OF THE MUNICIPAL DISTRICT OF BRAZEAU NO. 77, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE COUNTY OF PARKLAND NO. 31 FOR THE PURPOSE OF BASE COURSING SECONDARY ROAD NUMBER 759 FROM SECONDARY ROAD NUMBER 624 TO PROVINCIAL HIGHWAY NUMBER 39, BEING A DISTANCE OF APPROXIMATELY 18.4 KILOMETRES.

WHEREAS, Section 113 of the Municipal Government Act, R.S.A., 1980, and amendments thereto, provides for the passage of a By-Law authorizing the making of an agreement with any other Municipality for the construction of a public work; and

WHEREAS, Alberta Transportation and Utilities has requested that the Municipal District of Brazeau No. 77 proceed with the design, tendering and contract supervision of the 12.8 kilometres of base coursing within the Municipal District of Brazeau No. 7 and the 5.6 kilometres of base coursing within the County of Parkland No. 31.

WHEREAS, the Municipal District of Brazeau No. 77 and the County of Parkland No. 31 consider it desirable and cost-effective to plan and organize the 18.4 kilometres as one project.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Municipal District of Brazeau No. 77, in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled enacts as follows:

That the Municipal District of Brazeau No. 77 enter into an agreement with the County of Parland No. 31 providing for the Municipal District of Brazeau No. 77 to administer the design, tendering and contract supervision of the work, through its consultants, on the 18.4 kilometre section of Secondary Road Number 759.

READ a first time this 13th day of June, 1991, A.D.

READ a second time this 26th day of June, 1991, A.D.

READ a third time and finally passed this 26th day of June, 1991, A.D.
