

MUNICIPAL DISTRICT OF BRAZEAU NO. 77

BY-LAW NO. 213-94

BEING A BY-LAW OF THE MUNICIPAL DISTRICT OF BRAZEAU NO. 77 IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, TO AMEND AN AGREEMENT WITH HER MAJESTY THE QUEEN, IN RIGHT OF THE GOVERNMENT OF CANADA, HEREIN REPRESENTED BY THE ROYAL CANADIAN MOUNTED POLICE TO PROVIDE FOR THE DELEGATION OF SUPERVISION AND CONTROL OF THE MUNICIPAL DISTRICTS PUBLIC SAFETY CONSTABLES.

WHEREAS, under the provisions of Section 116 of the of the Municipal Government Act, being Chapter M-26 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1980, (as amended), the Council for the Municipal District of Brazeau No. 77, in the Province of Alberta, may pass a By-Law in right of the Government of Canada, hereinafter represented by the Royal Canadian Mounted Police to provide for the delegation of supervision and control of the Municipal District's Public Safety Constables.

WHEREAS, Bylaw 207-94 approved entering into an agreement outlining the responsibility of the Municipal District of Brazeau and the Royal Canadian Mounted Police, Drayton Valley detachment, with regards to the delegation of supervision and control of the Municipal District's Public Safety Constables, to the Royal Canadian Mounted Police, and


WHEREAS, following Council adoption of Bylaw 207-94, the Royal Canadian Mounted Police were desirous to make certain revisions prior to signing the Memorandum of Agreement..

Be it enacted that the Municipal Manager be authorized to execute the revised agreement as attached between the said Municipality and Her Majesty the Queen, in right of the Government of Canada, hereinafter represented by the RCMP, and that By-law 207-94 is rescinded upon passage of the bylaw.


READ a first time this 8 day of September, A.D., 1994.
