BYLAW NO: 760-11

BEING A BYLAW OF BRAZEAU COUNTY, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, TO AMEND LAND USE BYLAW NO. 474-04, AS AMENDED

WHEREAS, Council of Brazeau County deems it expedient and proper, under the authority of and in accordance with the Municipal Government Act, RSA 2000, Chapter M-26 and amendments thereto, to make certain amendments to Land Use Bylaw No. 474-04; As amended; and

WHEREAS, the public participation requirements of Section 692 of the Municipal Government Act, RSA 2000, Chapter M-26, have been complied with;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of Brazeau County, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

1. The addition of the definition:

“Outdoor Storage Facility, Temporary” means land and/or buildings used for the temporary (90 days) outdoor storage of goods and materials and may include the collection and distribution of goods and materials, excluding dangerous or hazardous goods and materials. One extension of 30 days may be granted at the discretion of the Development Officer. Only one outdoor storage facility, temporary, will be allowed per calendar year.”

2. The addition of **“Outdoor Storage Facility-Temporary*”** to Section 5.1(2).
“*Only one permit allowed per calendar year”.
3. That this Bylaw shall take effect upon the final passing thereof.

READ a first time this 21st day of June, 2011

READ a second time this 12th day of July, 2011

READ a third time and finally passed this 12th day of July, 2011
