Policy Statement

The Council of Brazeau County feels that the existing legislation and restrictions of livestock movement are sufficient to control the movement of livestock on or along municipally controlled roads. Council acknowledges that the ultimate responsibility for the safety of the animals and the travelling public is a joint effort between livestock operators and the travelling public. This policy applies only to those roads, which fall directly under the control of Brazeau County.

Policy

Livestock movement on or along roadways controlled by Brazeau County shall adhere to the relevant sections of the Highway Traffic Act, the Stray Animals Act and the Livestock Identification and Brand Inspection Act. Livestock movers are encouraged to take all necessary measures to ensure the safety of the travelling public and livestock.

The County may, from time to time, run advertisements to increase public awareness regarding the responsibilities of the travelling public and the livestock owner/caretaker in the movement of livestock along municipally controlled roadways.

The County shall, through the Agricultural Service Board make available signs for rental with a damage deposit sufficient to cover the replacement of the signs as outlined in the Schedule of Fees Bylaw.
